

WHAT'S ON in your local Library

As well as lending books, audio books and operating a 'Books at Home' service, the Library is the host to sales of a selection of nice cards and amazing second-hand books. The staff are always on hand to assist with reservations. It also hosts regular activities. These have included; Monday morning Baby Bounce/Word Play followed by Stay & Play. Wednesday drop in by East Suffolk Council and Barclays Bank. Also Friendship Fridays; games, coffee and chat for Adults.

There is a welcoming area where refreshments are provided, alongside the East Anglian Daily Times (paid for by Aldeburgh Library Foundation). There is space where you can meet informally or to research/study with two computers which can be booked. There is also a photocopier and scanner. With lots of local events and services on the display boards, and leaflets about local tourism locations, bus timetables and more!

Most of the Library furniture and book cases are moveable, and with it's lovely indoor/outdoor aspect and natural light it makes a terrific and flexible space for social events, annual meetings or parties. These are arranged via the Librarian and charged for.
